10% Proprietary Poa Trivialis

SEEDING RATES

New Seeding 4-6 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.
Overseeding 2-4 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.

Dense Shade, as its name suggests, is designed for areas where most common turf grasses will not grow due to lack of sunlight. While no grass will grow without sunlight, this special blend of fescue, ryegrass and poa varieties will grow where many others will not.

Dense Shade can be grown on a wide variety of soil types and has very good resistance to common turf diseases.

Dense Shade responds to average fertility rates, 1-4 lbs. of nitrogen per 1000 sq. ft. per season. It can be used successfully as an initial seeding or to overseed. It should be maintained at mowing heights of 2"-4".
